TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — Abraham and Sarah show hospitality to messengers of the LORD (Gn 18:1-10a).

Second Reading — Paul speaks of the stewardship given to him to complete the word of God, the mystery hidden from ages past (Colossians 1:24-28).

Gospel — Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. Mary has chosen the better part (Luke 10:38-42).

DON'T BE ANXIOUS

One can wonder how Luke's Gospel passage today might have been different if Mary, not Martha, had been the one to complain to Jesus, if Mary had said "Lord, look at her! Here you are sharing your wisdom and all she can think about is supper." Jesus may have noted, as Luke does, that Martha was burdened with much serving. As a fully human person, Jesus knew the human needs that had to be tended. He doesn't deny this, nor does he chastise Martha for her working in service. He chides her for being anxious and worried. How can Martha—or any of us—be anxious or worried about the serving that needs to be done when we do it in the context of the Lord's will and wisdom? The Church has done more

than any other institution to bear the heavy burdens of serving the ill, the uneducated, the suffering; has been "Martha" to countless of the little ones whom Christ told us were his very presence. But the Church has borne the burdens of service from the position of Mary: at the feet of the Lord, listening to and being guided by his word.

"Marta, Marta, staráš sa a znepokojuješ pre mnohé veci, a potrebné je len jedno. Mária si vybrala lepší podiel, ktorý sa jej neodníme." (Lk 10, 41-42)

Len jedno je potrebné: robiť to, čo je potrebné. A niet preto dôležitejšej starosti, ako denne sa dozvedať, čo je našou skutočnou potrebou a čo iba zdanlivou, umelo vytvorenou pod vplyvom reklamy zvonka alebo pod tlakom osobných vášní zvnútra. Kvôli tomu bude treba často a pravidelne otvárať evanjelium a sadať si s Máriou k Pánovým nohám a tam sa učiť rozlišovať prvoradá od prídavného, nutné od užitočného a užitočné od príjemného. Bez toho by sa aj nám služba čoskoro stala bremenom. Ak by sme ju takto cítili už teraz, mali ba sme vedieť, že v takomto prípade treba urobiť to, čo robila Mária. Sadnúť si k Pánovým nohám a pozorne sa započúvať do jeho slova.

SAINT SHARBEL MAKHLUF (1828-1898)

The convenience store owner chatted animatedly in Arabic with coworkers, but hardly at all with his "American" clientele. So soon after 9/11, he probably figured, with my accent, the less said, the better. That changed when an "American" customer recognized Saint Sharbel's portrait on the wall: "So you're Lebanese Maronites!" The owner was happily incredulous: "You know our saint?" "Not at first," the customer admitted. "But we help the Catholic Near East Welfare Association, and their magazine published that picture and called Sharbel the 'Paradoxical Artisan of Peace.'" "Everyone thinks we're Muslims," said the owner, "and some of my workers are. Saint Sharbel helps us live together in peace!" A hermit for twenty-three years, little is known of Sharbel's life. He died after suffering a stroke while celebrating the liturgy. Miracles attributed to his intercession number in the thousands, and in war-torn Lebanon, Catholics, Orthodox, and Muslims pray together where his incorrupt body is entombed. How lovely if after our passing, we too could be remembered for having brought very different people to the one God, together in peace.

SV. CHARBEL JOZEF MAKHLUF

Jozef Anton Makhluf sa narodil v roku 1828 v Bekaa Kafra v severnom Libanone. Vyrastal v opravdivej kresťanskej rodine, kde získal veľkú záľubu v modlitbe. Odišiel do opátstva sv. Marona v Annayi k maronitom, kde prijal meno Charbe, 1.11.1853 zložil sľuby a potom pokračoval v teologických štúdiách v opátstve sv. Kobriana a Justíny v Kfifane (Batroun). Za kňaza bol vysvätený 23. júla 1859 v Bkerky. V roku 1875 sa rozhodol pre život v pustovníka. Viedol život plný modlitby a vzdávania vďaky. 16. decembra 1898 ho počas slávenia sv. omše zachvátila zákerná choroba, ktorej podľahol na Štedrý večer toho istého roku. O pár mesiacov neskôr bolo vidieť okolo hrobu osľňujúce svetlo. Zástupy pútnikov začali prichádzať, aby sa k nemu modlili. Na jeho príhovor pútnici obdržali mnoho milostí, stali sa tam zázraky uzdravenia. Proces beatifikácie a kanonizácie sa začal v roku 1925.
